John 12 - 14

And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak. (John 12:50 AV)

John 15 - 18

But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not him that sent me. (John 15:21 AV)

And these things will they do unto you, because they have not known the Father, nor me." (John 16:3 AV)

I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. (John 17:6 AV)

John 19 - 21

But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name. (John 20:31 AV)

Acts 1 - 4

... Save yourselves from this untoward generation. 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added *unto them* about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. (Acts 2:40-42 AV)

Acts 5 - 8

Him hath God exalted with his right hand *to be* a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. (Acts 5:31 AV)

Acts 9 - 12

But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him. (Acts 10:35 AV)

Acts 13 - 15
